
ForwardHealth 2010 BadgerCare Plus HMO Report Card

Updated September, 2012

The Wisconsin ForwardHealth HMO Report Card can help you choose or change your HMO. It compares HMOs that serve Wisconsin BadgerCare Plus members in six areas of health care and four areas of member satisfaction.

This HMO Report Card uses the latest available information:

2010 data for Health Care Measures and 2008 data for Member Satisfaction.



Each Medicaid HMO has been given a letter grade (see scale on left) to show how it compares to Medicaid Providers across the country for *Health Care Measures*.

For example, if an HMO scored 76% in *Vaccines* and the Medicaid Average for that measure is 72%, the HMO scored 4% points higher than the Medicaid Average. That HMO's grade would be an A. HMOs at the cut-off points get the higher grade.

In addition, the scores for all measures in this Report Card were combined to give each HMO an *Overall Grade*.

Grades are based on how an HMO performs state-wide.

An HMO may perform better or worse in some parts of the state.

Health Care Measures

The health care ratings are based on information about the following services HMOs provided to BadgerCare Plus members:

- Asthma Care shows what percent of members with asthma in the HMO got the right medicine for asthma.
- The two *Diabetes* measures show what percent of adults with diabetes in the HMO received important blood tests.
 Diabetes 1 shows what percent of adults had a hemoglobin (HbA1C) test.
 Diabetes 2 shows what percent of adults had a cholesterol (LDL-C) test.
- Vaccines shows what percent of children in the HMO received all of their shots by their 2nd birthday.
- Blood Lead 1 shows what percent of children 1 year old or younger in the HMO had a blood lead test.
- Blood Lead 2 shows what percent of children 1 to 2 years of age in the HMO had a blood lead test.
- Smoking shows what percent of members who smoke got help to quit.

HMOs are held financially accountable for their performance in these six areas, and Wisconsin Medicaid is expanding the number of areas and measures for which the HMOs will continue to be accountable.
