- Criteria are sorted by yield (percent of cases for which an intervention was sent) and then by the total number of cases for which an intervention was sent.
- Not all criteria were selected for each cycle.
- A few criteria have too many cases to review for the cycle so the top scores are selected.
- The column labeled "% Letters actually sent" provides information about whether letters were sent after the final review.
- The letters per case give an indication whether the problem involves multiple or single providers.
