### Recommendation

#### Criteria 2367:

Alert Message: The overuse of migraine-specific medications (exceeding the recommended dosage and/or taking an agent more than 2 times a week may result in drug-induced rebound headaches. Unless contraindicated, consider the use of preventative medications such as beta-blockers, **tricyclic antidepressants**, **calcium channel blockers**, or SSRIs.
