FEATURE FOCUS: USING THE DRUG SEARCH TOOL AND PREFERRED DRUG LIST QUICK REFERENCE

Did you know that ForwardHealth has two ways you can find information on prescription drugs?

The Drug Search tool and the Preferred Drug List (PDL) Quick Reference are great provider resources, and both offer userfriendly features so you can always find exactly what you're looking for.

The Drug Search tool

The <u>Drug Search tool</u> gives you specific information about any drug billed using a National Drug Code (NDC) and covered by Wisconsin Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, SeniorCare, the Wisconsin Chronic Disease Program, and the HIV Drug Assistance Program.

There are three types of searches you can do with the Drug Search tool. You can:

- Find information on an individual drug.
- Find a list of NDCs by labeler code or with a similar name.

If you need information on what drugs are on our PDL and what prior authorization (PA) form is needed for each drug, look no further than the <u>PDL Quick Reference Guide</u>.

There are several forms related to the drugs on the PDL Quick Reference that are color-coded in the guide for your convenience.

What's one tip you'd like to give providers?

I'd like providers to review the Remittance Advice for our proprietary Explanation of Benefits because it is very detailed.

What's the best tool available in the Portal?

This is difficult for me to say, as all areas are needed! But if I had to choose one, it would be the Enrollment tab that appears after providers log in to their secure Portal accounts. That Enrollment tab shows the provider all the information they need to determine if and how they can provide services to members.

Is there anything more you'd like to share?

I really enjoy this position as it changes daily with new issues, training, and programs. There's never a dull moment!
