Adult Long-Term Care Provider Enrollment: Enrollment Is Open

This Adult Long-Term Care Update is the last in a series of Updates telling providers who deliver home and community-based services under one of Wisconsin's adult long-term care (LTC) waiver programs about how to enroll with Wisconsin Medicaid through the <u>ForwardHealth Portal</u> (referred to as the Portal for the remainder of this Update).

Enrollment is now open.

Supportive home care organizations should **not** enroll yet. Your provider type is not available in the application. ForwardHealth will let you know when you can enroll, likely in mid-2025.

This Adult Long-Term Care Update is for adult LTC waiver program providers in Family Care, Family Care Partnership, PACE, and IRIS.

Reminder: Who Needs to Enroll

ForwardHealth requires you to be enrolled with Wisconsin Medicaid, as described in Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS <u>105</u>:

- If you only provide adult LTC waiver services, you will need to use the Portal to **enroll for the first time**.
- If you are an existing Medicaid provider who also provides waiver services, you will access the Portal to add LTC waiver programs and services to your current Medicaid enrollment.

Note: The way you currently bill and submit claims for Family Care, Family Care Partnership, PACE, and IRIS services will stay the same.

Enrollment Scenarios and Instructions to Get Started

If you only provide adult LTC waiver services and need to enroll for the first time:

- 1. Access the <u>Portal</u> homepage.
- 2. Select the **Become a Provider** link on the left side of the page. The Provider Enrollment Information homepage will display.
- 3. On the upper left side of the page, click <u>Start or Continue</u> <u>Your Enrollment Application</u>.
- 4. In the To Start a New Medicaid Enrollment box, click <u>Medicaid/Border Status Provider Enrollment Application</u>.
- 5. Click Next after reading the instructions.
- 6. Navigate through the enrollment wizard, enter or select the applicable information, and then click **Next** to continue.

If you are an existing Medicaid provider and need to add LTC waiver programs and services to your current Medicaid enrollment:

- 1. Access the <u>Portal</u> homepage.
- 2. On the upper right side of the page, click Login.
- Log in to your secure Portal account. The secure Provider Portal page will display.
- 4. On the right side of the page in the Home Page box, click **Update Adult LTC Waiver Service(s) or Program(s)**.

TWO EASY STEPS TO ACCESS THE ONLINE PORTAL





OPEN YOUR CAMERA APP

Open your smartphone's camera app and hold it over the QR code so you see the QR code as if you were taking a picture of it. A prompt to follow a link should appear on your screen.





If it does not, you can download a QR code reader from your app store, for free, to then scan and open the QR code's hyperlink. Open the QR code reader, hold it over the QR code, and it will help you open the link.

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
