# **Summary of Changes**

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# 3M™ Enhanced Ambulatory Patient Groups (EAPG) Summary of Changes

For licensees of the 3M™ Enhanced Ambulatory Patient Groups (EAPGs), this document identifies changes for v3.16, effective January 1, 2021.

The EAPG grouper v3.16 contains versions 3.10 through v3.16; seven years' worth of grouper versions are retained (2015 through 2021). Additionally, Grouper Version 3.8 and 3.9 remain in the grouper component through 2021 for historical claims processing. However, code set updates are not included. Effective January 1, 2022, version 3.8 and 3.9 will be removed from the component.

Each year, 3M revises the EAPG patient classification logic for two reasons:

- 1. To accommodate changes in health care code sets, most importantly the International Classification of Diseases, Version 10, Clinical Modification (ICD-10-CM), the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT), and the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS). The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) usually does an annual update to the ICD-10-CM code set each October 1. This year, there were also new codes introduced April 1, 2020, and planned for January 1, 2021. The American Medical Association makes its major update to the CPT each January 1 and makes some additional updates quarterly. DHHS updates the HCPCS code set quarterly. 3M releases quarterly updates of the EAPG logic to reflect code set updates made during the year.
- 2. 3M continually performs research to enhance the clinical precision of the EAPG logic, that is, how patients are classified into one or more EAPGs per ambulatory care visit. These enhancements are implemented each year with the January 1 release.

As shown in Table 1, between October 1, 2019, and January 1, 2021, there is a net increase of 437 ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes, or 0.6%. Table 2 shows a net increase of 47 CPT®/HCPCS codes or 0.3%.

**Note:** Totals for CPT® and HCPCS codes include the April, July, and October 2020, and January 2021 code updates. The rows for total, new, and deleted codes compare the January 2020 to January 2021 counts.

In addition to changes to reflect modifications in the national diagnosis and procedure code sets, 3M is making several enhancements to the clinical logic. In updating the clinical logic, changes have been made to improve the precision of the clinical logic by considering customer recommendations, shifts in coding, changes in practice, and economic cost shifts.

As coding systems are revised, and new technology and advances in medicine occur, the need for new EAPG groups, as well as code assignment changes to EAPG groups, are reviewed and evaluated each year. New EAPG groups may be added, and obsolete groups may be deleted. Modifications occur due to code assignment changes, and groups are reviewed for clinical homogeneity across current industry trends, claim reporting frequency and reimbursement. A comparison table of the EAPG changes between 3.15 and 3.16 is provided in Table 3 below.

Highlights of the changes made to the EAPG grouper field and logic changes are listed below. More detailed information about clinical changes made to EAPGs is provided later in this document.

New input fields: None

• New output fields:

- New line item output flag for identifying when services are reported with modifier PN, PO, or ER; indicating that the service was provided in an off-campus provider-based department. Since this is just an output flag for payers to refer to for any of their payment policies this output flag is provided for all active versions of EAPG.
- New line item output flag for identifying Unlisted Procedure (CPT/HC`PCS) codes. Since this is just an output flag that payers can refer to, to identify and monitor the reporting of unlisted procedure codes this output flag is provided for all active versions of EAPG.
- Grouper logic changes (Existing Options with new values or modifications):
  - The default setting for the Modifier 59 Options is turned off. This default setting is applicable to 3.16 only. Note that this change significantly increased the number of available claims used for creation of the relative weights. Previously, claims containing modifier 59 were not used in the weights process as there is an override of consolidation; the preference for weight setting is to include claims that do consolidate significant procedures.
  - Added new option setting value "2" (Assign medical visit and observation; do not package observation if 8 or more hours are present" to existing options for "Process Medical Visit with Significant Procedures". This new option setting value 2 is the default setting in v3.16 for the Process Medical Visit with Significant Procedure Types 21 (Physical Therapy & Rehab), 22 (Behavioral Health & Counseling), 23 (Dental Procedure), 24 (Radiologic Procedure), and 25 (Diagnostic or Therapeutic Procedure). By setting this new value 2 it allows a Medical Visit to pay separately with a Significant Procedure type 21-25. The new value also processes Observation claims by paying separately for both a Medical visit and Observation (EAPG 450) services in the presence of significant procedure types 21-25, if 8 or more hours of observation is reported. For versions prior to 3.16, the default values for the "Process Medical Visit with Significant Procedures" options remain the same. The new Option setting value "2" is being made available for grouper versions 3.12 - 3.15 to manually set, if a payer chooses to do so. **Note:** Although a user may set value 2 to determine EAPG results, the standard observation requirements need to be satisfied in order to not package the observation hours. In circumstances where standard observation requirements are not met (less than 8 hours of observation reported), and the option setting is "2", the medical visit is assigned but observation services (EAPG 450) continue to be packaged. Nationally recognized observation standards (i.e. Medicare OPPS) deem it appropriate to pay separately for observation only when a patient is under observation for at least 8 or more hours. This standard was used in the requirements of new option value 2 and is required within the logic in order to pay separately in the presence of significant procedures 21-25 regardless of a payers' hourly settings under the Observation Hours option.
  - Added Preventive Diabetes diagnosis code (R73.03) to be appliable to the Preventive Diabetes logic for output of preventive flag; applicable to 3.16 only.
  - Added new Claim Processed Warning flag value 5 (Claim processed as single visit due to single visit claim action revenue code option list) to identify when a claim is processed as a single visit due to the Single Visit Claim Action Revenue Code option settings. This logic is applicable for all versions of EAPG (v3.10-3.16)

- Added new Claim Processed Warning flag value 6 (Claim processed under multiple medical visit option conditions which sets modifier 27 option) to identify claims containing multiple medical visits processed and the modifier 27 option is not enabled. This logic is applicable for all versions of EAPG (v3.10-3.16)
- Added new Claim Processed Warning flag value 7 (Claim processed with observation hours options overridden by process medical visit with significant procedure options requirement of > 8 hours) to identify claims where the "Process Medical Visit With" option is set to 2 and the Observation Hourly Option setting is not set to 2 and 8 or more hours of observation is not present. This logic update is applicable for v3.16 only at default and available for versions 3.12-3.15 if the Process Medical Visit Significant Procedure Options manually sets new option setting value 2: Assign medical visit and observation; do not package observation if 8 or more hours are present.
- Added new Claim Processed Warning flag value 8 (Claim processed as multiple visit due to single visit claim action revenue code option criteria not met) to identify claims that report a revenue code from the Single Visit Claim Action Revenue Code option list, but no HCPCS. Revenue Code Only lines cannot set the claim action flag to 1. This logic update is applied to v3.16 only.
- Updated Single Visit Claim Action Revenue Code logic to set the claim action flag to 1
  only if an applicable revenue code is present with a valid HCPCS code. Revenue code
  only lines cannot set the claim action flag to 1. This logic update is applied to v3.16 only.
- Add new line item unassigned flag (LIUF) value 23 (revenue code only line) to be returned when EAPG 999 is assigned due to a revenue code only line for v3.16 only. A revision to the logic of (LIUF) value 9 (invalid procedure blank HCPCS) is required to no longer return LIUF 9 in instances of a revenue code only line. If a blank HCPCS is submitted and no revenue code is present, then LIUF value 9 is applied. In the instance of no HCPCS code but a revenue code is present, then LIUF value 23 is applied.
- Update the Observation hours logic (EAPG 450) to sum the hours (units of service) of observation reported when multiple lines of HCPCS G0378 are present on a claim. This logic update is applied to v3.16 only.

#### Clinical logic changes:

- Removed 929 procedures from the Inpatient Only procedure EAPG (993); 657 are added to new EAPGs, and 272 procedures are added to existing EAPGs. There are 20 new EAPGs added as a result of assigning the 657 procedures codes to groupable EAPGs.
- Reviewed Laparoscopy Surgery procedures (EAPG 145, 145, 147, and 148) for reassignment into anatomical or clinically related EAPGs
- Major surgery changes for Significant Procedure type 2 procedures, including cardiovascular, musculoskeletal and gastrointestinal procedures
- New structure for Ophthalmologic category procedures
- New groups for Opioid Treatment Program services
- Ancillary EAPG type changes

- Changes to the ancillary standard packaging list
- Changes to pharmacotherapy, therapeutic radiopharmaceuticals, brachytherapy sources and blood product EAPGs
- Medical visit EAPG changes, continuing efforts to align diagnosis code assignment for outpatient visit encounters to those observed in the inpatient setting under DRGs in the APR DRG grouper
- Additional details for all clinical logic changes are provided in the subsequent sections, and may also be viewed in the spreadsheet attachment, "Annual Summary of Changes v3.16"

### **EAPG Changes**

For EAPG 3.16, there are 59 new EAPGs, 14 deleted EAPGs, and 52 revised EAPG descriptions. Note that any references to outpatient claims data set in the details substantiating changes in assignment of codes or the development of new EAPGs is associated with the review of source claims from the CMS OPPS CY 2019 data set, which contains a total of 112 million claims.

#### **EAPG** type changes

Over the past few years, in our observation of claims in the data set for how outpatient services are reported, it is clear that there are significant changes required to the type classification for EAPG groups in order to improve the packaging or bundling of services for constructing efficient payment. Many services designated as a significant procedure type 2, 21, 22, 23, 24 or 25 have been changed to an ancillary type 4 as they are recognized as either a routine or supportive diagnostic or therapeutic service that is not necessarily significant, but supportive to the patient's diagnosis or major procedure or therapeutic service performed. There is a total of 19 EAPGs that had a type change from a significant procedure type to an ancillary type.

In considering major or significant surgical procedures, we are reserving type 2 for those events and classifying less significant surgical, diagnostic or therapeutic procedures to type 25. There is a total of 18 EAPGs that had a type change from significant procedure type 2 to type 25 and only 1 EAPG that has been changed from a type 25 to 2.

Overall, 38 EAPG groups had type changes, the list for which can be found in the attachment, tab "EAPG\_LIST\_TYPE\_MOD".

Listed below are some of the EAPGs with type changes to ancillary EAPGs that appeared most frequently in the data set, total ancillary type changes represent approximately 3.5% of outpatient encounters reporting these ancillary EAPGs.
