What is Care4Kids?

Care4Kids is a comprehensive health care program for your child. Care4Kids recognizes that your child deserves comprehensive and coordinated health care provided by a doctor who understands your child's needs. You will be involved, with the team, in appointments, health care decisions, and planning involving your child's health care.

All children in Out of Home Care are enrolled in Medicaid. Care4Kids is a choice for specialized Medicaid that coordinates your child's care. The program is voluntary. You can enroll your child in the Care4Kids program or discontinue your child's enrollment in the Care4Kids program at any time and for any reason.

What healthcare services will my child receive?

Care4Kids provides the full range of Medicaid-covered health services. These services are to meet the needs of your child. These include:

- A Health Screen within 2 days of placement in out of home care;
- A Comprehensive Initial Health Assessment within 30 days of placement in out of home care;
- A mental health screen;
- Dental care;
- Vision care;
- Routine check-ups;
- A Comprehensive Health Care Plan; and
- Physical and mental health services based on your child's needs.

What happens next?

An Enrollment Specialist will contact you to discuss and provide additional details about the **Care4Kids** program. The Enrollment Specialist will answer any questions you have about Care4Kids program, and confirm your choice to enroll your child.
