# 2021 Wisconsin Act 98 Overview

# 2021 Wisconsin Act 98

Act was enacted into law on December 3, 2021.

Authorizes the department to reimburse services that are provided by a licensed pharmacist.

Services provided are to be in the scope of the pharmacist's license or performed under a collaborative practice agreement.


Requires the department to submit a state plan amendment (SPA) and receive approval from Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).

#### 2021 Wisconsin Act 98

- Act 98 expands the Medicaid medical benefit by allowing pharmacists to perform and bill for medical services.
- The Department of Health Services
   (DHS) plans to implement a broad set of services as allowable.

**Enrollment** Service Package State Plan Amendment Communications

#### Enrollment

Pharmacists will enroll with the Medicaid program as a provider.

- DMS is creating a new enrollment pathway for pharmacists.
- Pharmacists will complete the enrollment process through the ForwardHealth Portal.
  - Application
  - Include appropriate documentation
  - No enrollment fee for pharmacists
  - Every three years pharmacists will need to reenroll

### Service Package

- DMS is identifying billable services for pharmacists.
  - Gathered stakeholder feedback
  - DHS meeting on April 27, 2023, for additional external stakeholder feedback
  - Operationalize at the procedure code level
- Build the system to allow pharmacists to bill for services.
- Define service package to estimate utilization and fiscal impact.

#### Medicaid State Plan

- Agreement between CMS and DHS regarding how the Medicaid program is implemented in Wisconsin.
- Amend the state plan to identify pharmacists as Medicaid providers, define the scope of services allowed, and identify the reimbursement methodology.

#### SPA Process

- Draft language and fiscal estimate
  - Provider/benefit authority
  - Reimbursement authority
- Brief the tribes
- Post public notice
- Submit to CMS
  - Submitted quarterly
  - Can backdate to the first day of the quarter

#### Communications

#### ForwardHealth Updates

- Written communications for providers
- Plan for at least two updates
  - Enrollment
  - Service package and reimbursement structure
- Updates are posted on the ForwardHealth Portal
- Will share with Pharmacy Society of Wisconsin and other partners for distribution

#### **Training**

- Enrollment
- ForwardHealth coverage policy and claims submission

  - Defining service package and reimbursement methodology
- **Q**3 2023
  - Provider enrollment pathway built
  - Train and enroll providers
- Q4 2023
  - Service package built
  - Train providers on policy and billing for services
