For Primary Care Providers to Refer Well Woman Program client to a MS Center for a consultation and diagnostic testing for multiple sclerosis:

- Client eligibility: Confirm the client's enrollment in Well Woman with your local WWWP Coordinator.
- Provide the beginning MS assessment (office visit only) and determine need for referral to MS Center for consultation and MS diagnostic testing.
- "MS Report & Referral" form: Complete the Client and Primary Care Provider sections. Make sure the client's and WWWP Local Coordinator's telephone numbers are on the Form.
- Making referral: Fax the "MS Report & Referral" form and your clinical referral notes to the MS Center.
- Scheduling appointment for MS testing: The MS Center will call the client to schedule an appointment.
- Client information: Give client a copy of "MS Testing: Client Page for WWWP". Ask client to "hand carry" any old MS testing records or results to her MS Center appointment.
- Submitting claims: Send a copy of completed "MS Report & Referral" form and claim for beginning MS assessment to:
