### Reimbursement Paused for Administration of Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine

Effective immediately, ForwardHealth will not reimburse for administration of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine for dates of service on and after April 13, 2021. ForwardHealth will reimburse claims for the administration of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine with dates of service between February 27, 2021, and April 12, 2021.

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services is advising all providers to stop administering this vaccine to members until further notice.

ForwardHealth will publish additional guidance when the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices and Department of Health Services have cleared the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine for further use.
