COVID-19 Unwinding: Hospital Billing for COVID-19 Vaccine Administration

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During the federal COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE), the federal government allowed the Wisconsin Department of Health Services to implement temporary changes to some policies to facilitate the protection of member health. ForwardHealth Update 2021-18, "Hospital Billing for COVID-19 Vaccine Administration," outlined temporary exceptions to the hospital claims submission process for COVID-19 vaccine administration.

The federal government has announced that the COVID-19 PHE will end on May 11, 2023. **As of May 12, 2023**, hospitals should return to submitting all claims for vaccine administration on facility claims when performed by hospital staff.
