

BACKGROUND

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services published the federal [Covered Outpatient Drugs Final Rule \(CMS-2345-FC\)](#) in January 2016 to address the rise in prescription drug costs by ensuring that Medicaid programs reformed payment methodologies for prescription drugs to accurately reflect actual cost.

In accordance with the federal rule, ForwardHealth implemented a professional dispensing fee reimbursement rate structure based on a provider's annual prescription volume, effective for dates of service on and after April 1, 2017. Providers must complete an annual prescription volume attestation survey to determine their annual prescription volume and assign each of them a professional dispensing fee.

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SURVEY FORMATS AND ACCESSIBILITY

Question #1: How can I access the Prescription Volume Attestation Survey?

Answer: Providers can access the Prescription Volume Attestation Survey via a web-based tool or a Microsoft Excel template. The Prescription Volume Attestation Survey is accessible until Friday, February 6, 2026.

The [web-based survey](#) is secure and requires a username and password. Providers can access the web-based survey using the unique login information sent by ForwardHealth in the prescription volume attestation survey letter.

The Microsoft Excel survey can be downloaded from the [Annual Prescription Volume Attestation Resources](#) page of the ForwardHealth Portal (the Portal). Providers can ask for a copy of the Excel template by emailing CODSurvey@mercer.com.

Completed Excel surveys should be emailed back to CODSurvey@mercer.com or faxed to 212-948-0047, to the attention of Kerri Wade by Friday, February 6, 2026.

Providers can ask for a faxed paper copy of the survey by emailing CODSurvey@mercer.com or calling the Mercer survey hotline at 844-294-9982 (available Monday–Friday, 9 a.m.–5 p.m. Central Time [CT]). Providers can submit the completed paper survey using the above email address or fax number.

Question #2: I didn't receive a username and password from ForwardHealth (or my login information does not work). Whom should I contact?

Answer: For all username, password, and survey accessibility questions, providers should call the Mercer survey hotline at 844-294-9982 (available Monday–Friday, 9 a.m.–5 p.m. CT).

Question #3: I won't be able to complete the web-based survey in one session. Can I come back to it and complete it later?

Answer: If a survey cannot be filled out in one session, the provider can save the partially completed web-based survey without losing entered information. When the web-based survey is completed, the provider must click **Submit** to send the survey to Mercer.

Question #4: How long will the survey take to complete?

Answer: The survey will take approximately five minutes to complete.

Question #5: What is the deadline for survey completion?

Answer: Providers are required to submit their completed Prescription Volume Attestation Survey by Friday, February 6, 2026.

SURVEY COMPLETION GUIDANCE

Question #6: Are there instructions for completing the survey?

Answer: Yes, providers should refer to the Prescription Volume Attestation Survey Instructions available on the [Annual Prescription Volume Attestation Resources](#) page of the Portal for guidance on how to fill out the survey.

Question #7: How do I attest for multiple locations?

Answer: Providers who have multiple locations must attest for each location individually. The Excel version of the survey lets providers submit a single survey document for multiple locations.

Question #8: What if I don't know my Wisconsin Medicaid ID number?

Answer: If necessary, providers can use the Switch Organization function from their secure Portal account homepage to view their eight- or nine-digit Wisconsin Medicaid ID number, which is listed as the Wisconsin Provider ID on the panel. Providers can also contact the Provider Services Call Center at 800-947-9627 if they are still unable to obtain their Wisconsin Provider ID.

Question #9: What is the reporting period?

Answer: As indicated in the Prescription Volume Attestation Survey Instructions available on the [Annual Prescription Volume Attestation Resources](#) page of the Portal, the reporting period is the calendar year 2025.

Question #10: How should providers with less than one year of data attest their prescription volume?

Answer: Providers can submit their available data. They should enter the 2025 date range in Element 3 of the survey if the reported prescription volume covers a different time period than January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025.

Question #11: How should prescription volume be reported for organizations that have undergone a change of ownership during calendar year 2025?

Answer: For a change of ownership in calendar year 2025, providers should report prescription volume only for the dates included in the **current** ownership. Providers should enter that 2025 date range for the reported prescription volume in Element 3 of the survey.

Question #12: How should prescription volume be reported for a remote dispensing site?

Answer: Providers should include prescriptions dispensed from a remote dispensing site in the annual prescription volume reported for the Medicaid-enrolled provider. Remote dispensing sites are licensed under the enrolled pharmacy provider's National Provider Identifier (NPI).

Question #13: How do I calculate my annual prescription volume?

Answer: Providers should include **all** prescriptions dispensed, not just Medicaid prescriptions, for DOS during the 2025 calendar year.

Question #14: What counts in the claim volume attestation? Is that per company? Location? What will the total claim volume be reported by?

Answer: The total claim volume attestation should be based on each NPI approved as a DHS pharmacy provider.

SURVEY PARTICIPATION

Question #15: Who is required to attest and complete the prescription volume attestation survey?

Answer: Providers who submit claims to ForwardHealth with National Drug Codes **must attest** to their annual prescription volume, with the exception of federally qualified health centers (FQHCs) and out-of-state providers. For those who are required to attest, ForwardHealth will assign the lowest professional dispensing fee reimbursement rate if the Prescription Volume Attestation Survey is not completed by Friday, February 6, 2026.

SURVEY RESULTS

Question #16: When will I receive a professional dispensing fee reimbursement rate assignment based on the survey?

Answer: ForwardHealth will notify providers of their rate assignments in March 2026. ForwardHealth will assign providers who didn't fill out the survey the lowest professional dispensing fee reimbursement rate.

Question #17: What are the professional dispensing fee reimbursement rates?

Answer: The professional dispensing fee reimbursement rates, which are based on annual prescription volume, are:

- 1–34,999 prescriptions/year: \$15.69
- 35,000+ prescriptions/year: \$10.51

Note: An FQHC-specific professional dispensing fee rate of \$24.92 applies to eligible claims for FQHCs. Out-of-state providers are assigned a professional dispensing fee reimbursement rate of \$10.51.

Question #18: My prescription volume has changed since initial reporting. When am I eligible for a professional dispensing fee reimbursement rate reassignment?

Answer: Providers are only eligible for professional dispensing fee reimbursement rate reassessments during the annual attestation process. Professional dispensing fee reimbursement rates won't be adjusted to account for prescription volume changes.
