- Ophthalmics, Glaucoma Agents (Treatment of eye condition that can cause sight loss)

- Antihistamines, Minimally Sedating (Allergies)
- Intranasal Rhinitis -- Astelin (Allergies)
- Lipotropics, Other -- Antara (Cholesterol lowering)
