Dear Nasha Scott:

This letter is a statutory NOTICE of VIOLATION and imposed ORDER on the licensee of Amazing Care Group Home LLC 2, located at 734 S 39th St, Milwaukee, and sets forth appeal rights, if any. This regulatory action is taken by the Department of Health Services (Department) pursuant to Wis. Stat § 50.033(2), and Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

On March 9, 2026, a standard survey, two complaint investigations and a self-report investigation were concluded for Amazing Care Group Home LLC 2 by the Division of Quality Assurance, Bureau of Assisted Living, to determine if the above-referenced facility was in substantial compliance with Wis. Stat. ch. 50 or Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 88, or both, which set forth requirements for the administration and operation of an adult family home (AFH). The Department is issuing Statement of Deficiency (SOD) # FT8F11 for violations of Wis. Stat. ch. 50 or Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 88, which establish the grounds for this action. SOD #FT8F11 is enclosed.

ORDER TO COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS

1. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.03(6)(g)2.b., effective immediately, the licensee shall comply with the requirements specified by Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 88 that establishes the standards for the operation of the Adult Family Home in order to protect and promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents.

AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AND WITHOUT DELAY, within 45 days of receipt of this notice, the licensee shall achieve and maintain substantial compliance with all requirements. All operational and resident records required as evidence of compliance with applicable rules will be available to department representatives upon request.

The Department may, without notice, conduct an inspection to verify the licensee's corrective action at any time after the date of compliance. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.033(3), the department may impose a \$200 inspection fee for an on-site inspection to review compliance of violations resulting in enforcement action.

ADDITIONALLY:

WITHIN 10 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the licensee may request an extension for the date of compliance. The request for an extension must be submitted to the Assisted Living Regional Director, Southeastern Regional Office, at DHSDQABALSERO@dhs.wisconsin.gov. The Regional Director will communicate to the licensee a decision on the date of compliance extension.

SPECIAL ORDERS

Based on the results of the Department's investigation, and pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.02(2)(am)2., **EFFECTIVE UPON RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE and ORDER**, the Department of Health Services **HEREBY ORDERS** that **Amazing Care Group Home LLC 2:**

1. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.03(6)(g)2.e., effective immediately, the licensee shall develop and implement corrective measures to ensure that residents receive proper care and treatment, that their health and safety are protected and promoted and that their rights are respected. The licensee shall develop and implement corrective measures to resolve each deficiency identified in Statement of Deficiency (SOD) FT8F11. The licensee's corrective measures shall ensure the following:

WITHIN 7 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the licensee shall provide the legal representative and case manager (if any) for each resident with a copy of SOD FT8F11 and a copy of this Notice and Order letter. The licensee shall retain evidence, acceptable to the department, to verify compliance with this order. Acceptable documentation will be a signed, certified mail receipt or a verification letter or email from each legal representative and case manager.

WITHIN 45 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the licensee shall hold a care conference for Resident 1 with their legal representative, and case manager (if any), for the purpose of reviewing the resident's individual service plan (ISP) to include a discussion of their supervision needs, behavioral support interventions, and access in and out of the facility. The licensee will not arbitrarily impose a restriction on a resident's freedom of choice. Any restriction will be supported by a specific assessed need and justified in the resident's individual service plan. The licensee will obtain a statement of agreement with the plan, dated and signed by all persons involved in developing the plan. All staff responsible for providing services to a resident will review the ISP and provide services in accordance with the plan.

All documentation required by Order #1 will be made available to department representatives upon request.
