Dear Francine Carter:

This letter is a statutory NOTICE of VIOLATION and imposed ORDER on the licensee of Above and Beyond Health Care Services, located at 4341 N. 19th St. Milwaukee, and sets forth appeal rights, if any. This regulatory action is taken by the Department of Health Services (Department) pursuant to Wis. Stat § 50.033(2), and Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

On September 17, 2025, a standard survey, verification visit and complaint investigation was concluded for Above and Beyond Health Care Services by the Division of Quality Assurance, Bureau of Assisted Living, to determine if the above-referenced facility was in substantial compliance with Wis. Stat. ch. 50 or Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 88, or both, which set forth requirements for the administration and operation of an adult family home (AFH). The Department is issuing Statement of Deficiency (SOD) #NFIP12 for violations of Wis. Stat. ch.

50 or Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 88, which establish the grounds for this action. SOD #NFIP12 is enclosed.

ORDER TO COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS

1. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.03(6)(g)2.b., effective immediately, the licensee shall comply with the requirements specified by Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 88 that establishes the standards for the operation of the Adult Family Home in order to protect and promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents.

AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AND WITHOUT DELAY, within 45 days of receipt of this notice, the licensee shall achieve and maintain substantial compliance with all requirements. All operational and resident records required as evidence of compliance with applicable rules will be available to department representatives upon request.

The Department may, without notice, conduct an inspection to verify the licensee's corrective action at any time after the date of compliance. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.033(3), the department may impose a \$200 inspection fee for an on-site inspection to review compliance of violations resulting in enforcement action.

ADDITIONALLY:

WITHIN 10 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the licensee may request an extension for the date of compliance. The request for an extension must be submitted to the Assisted Living Regional Director, Southeastern Regional Office, at DHSDQABALSERO@dhs.wisconsin.gov. The Regional Director will communicate to the licensee a decision on the date of compliance extension.

ORDER NOT TO ADMIT NEW OR ADDITIONAL RESIDENTS

Based on the results of the Department's investigation and pursuant to authority provided in Wis. Stat. § 50.02(2)(am)2., and Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.03(6)(g)2.f., **EFFECTIVE UPON RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE and ORDER**, the Department of Health Services **HEREBY ORDERS** that **Above and Beyond Health Care Services LLC NOT ADMIT ANY NEW OR ADDITIONAL RESIDENTS** until all violations in Statement of Deficiency NFIP12 are corrected, compliance is verified by the Department, and this Order is rescinded in writing.

SPECIAL ORDERS

Based on the results of the Department's investigation, and pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.02(2)(am)2., **EFFECTIVE UPON RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE and ORDER**, the Department of Health Services **HEREBY ORDERS** that **Above and Beyond Health Care Services:**

1. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.03(6)(g)2.e., EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, the licensee shall ensure all residents receive proper care and treatment, that their health and safety are protected and promoted and that their rights are respected. The licensee shall develop and implement corrective measures to resolve each deficiency identified in Statement of Deficiency NFIP11. The licensee's corrective measures shall include the following:

WITHIN 7 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the licensee shall provide each current resident's legal representative and case manager (if any) with a copy of Statement of Deficiency NFIP12 and a copy of this Notice and Order letter. The licensee shall retain evidence, acceptable to the department, to verify compliance with this Order. Acceptable documentation will be a signed, certified mail receipt or a verification letter or email from the legal representative and case manager. Required evidence will be made available to the department representatives upon request.

WITHIN 14 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the licensee shall hold a care conference for Resident 2, with their legal representative, and case manager (if any), for the purpose of discussing the resident's mobility needs and the resident's access to the home and within the home.

WITHIN 45 DAYS of receipt of this notice, if compliance with Wis. Admin. Code §§ DHS 88.05(2)(a) and 88.05(2)(d) is not achieved, the licensee shall establish a relocation plan addressing the discharge of any resident who is not able to walk at all, or able to walk only with difficulty, or only with the assistance of crutches, a cane or walker, or is unable to easily negotiate stairs without assistance.

NOTICE OF REVISIT FEE

According to Wis. Stat. § 50.033(3), if the Department takes enforcement action against an adult family home for violation of this subchapter or rules promulgated under it, and the Department subsequently conducts an onsite inspection to review the facility's action to correct the violation(s), the Department may impose a \$200 inspection fee on the adult family home.

On September 17, 2025, a verification visit was concluded at Above and Beyond Health Care Services by the Division of Quality Assurance, Bureau of Assisted Living, to determine if the violation(s) contained in Statement of Deficiency (SOD) #NFIP11 were corrected. **Therefore, an inspection fee of \$200 is being assessed.**

The revisit fee is due within ten (10) days of receipt of this Notice. Failure to submit this revisit fee will result in additional department action against Above and Beyond Health Care Services. There are no appeal rights for revisit fees.
