Dear Miranda Young:

This letter is a statutory NOTICE of VIOLATION and imposed ORDER on the licensee of A+ Just Like Family Franklin B, located at 1619 Franklin St B, Racine, and sets forth appeal rights, if any. This regulatory action is taken by the Department of Health Services (Department) pursuant to Wis. Stat § 50.033(2), and Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

On February 25, 2026, a monitoring visit was concluded for A+ Just Like Family Franklin B by the Division of Quality Assurance, Bureau of Assisted Living, to determine if the above-referenced facility was in substantial compliance with Wis. Stat. ch. 50 or Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 88, or both, which set forth requirements for the administration and operation of an adult family home (AFH). The Department is issuing Statement of Deficiency (SOD) #S19311 for violations of Wis. Stat. ch. 50 or Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 88, which establish the grounds for this action. SOD #S19311 is enclosed.

ORDER TO COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS

1. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.03(6)(g)2.b., effective immediately, the licensee shall comply with the requirements specified by Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 88 that establishes the standards for the operation of the Adult Family Home in order to protect and promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents.

AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AND WITHOUT DELAY, within 45 days of receipt of this notice, the licensee shall achieve and maintain substantial compliance with all requirements. All operational and resident records required as evidence of compliance with applicable rules will be available to department representatives upon request.

The Department may, without notice, conduct an inspection to verify the licensee's corrective action at any time after the date of compliance. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.033(3), the department may impose a \$200 inspection fee for an on-site inspection to review compliance of violations resulting in enforcement action.

ADDITIONALLY:

WITHIN 10 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the licensee may request an extension for the date of compliance. The request for an extension must be submitted to the Assisted Living Regional Director, Southeastern Regional Office, at DHSDQABALSERO@dhs.wisconsin.gov. The Regional Director will communicate to the licensee a decision on the date of compliance extension.

SPECIAL ORDERS

Based on the results of the Department's investigation, and pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.02(2)(am)2., **EFFECTIVE UPON RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE and ORDER**, the Department of Health Services **HEREBY ORDERS** that **A+ Just Like Family Franklin B:**

1. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 88.03(6)(g)2.e., effective immediately, the licensee shall ensure all residents receive proper care and treatment, that their health and safety are protected and promoted and that their rights are respected.

WITHIN 7 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the licensee shall provide the legal representative and the case manager (if any) for each resident with a copy of Statement of Deficiency (SOD) S19311 and a copy of this Notice and Order letter. The licensee shall retain evidence, acceptable to the department, to verify compliance with this Order. Acceptable documentation will be a signed, certified mail receipt or a verification letter or email from each legal representative and case manager.

WITHIN 45 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the licensee shall develop and implement corrective measures to resolve the deficiency identified in SOD S19311. The corrective measures will include, at a minimum, the development (or review) of a written procedure to address:

Adequate Staffing, how the provider will ensure:

- (a) A service provider is present in the licensed entity and awake at all times if any resident is in need of continuous care.
- (b) The staffing patterns will be sufficient to meet the personal care needs of residents, to ensure needed supervision, to provide needed services (e.g., toileting, bathing, medication management, behavioral interventions, personal cares, meals), and to facilitate a safe evacuation of the building in the event of an emergency.
- (c) A process for an employee to implement in the event of service provider absences or emergencies, including required duties and current notifications.

The licensee will provide training to all service providers on the written procedure required by this Order. Training will be documented in personnel records and will include the date/duration of training, the signature/qualifications of the instructor, and evidence of successful completion of the training.

All documentation to evidence compliance with Order #1 will be made available to department representatives upon request.
