Dear Tina Nelsen:

This letter is a statutory NOTICE of VIOLATION and imposed ORDER on the operator of Patriot Place RCAC, located at 609 Broadway Street, Berlin, WI 54923, and sets forth appeal rights, if any. This regulatory action is taken by the Department of Health Services (Department) pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.034, and Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 89.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

On September 15, 2023, a Verification Visit, Complaint Investigation, and Self Report Review were concluded for Patriot Place RCAC by the Division of Quality Assurance, Bureau of Assisted Living, to determine if the above-referenced facility was in substantial compliance with Wis. Stat. ch. 50 or Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 89, or both, which set forth requirements for the administration and operation of a residential care apartment complex (RCAC). The Department is issuing Statement of Deficiency (SOD) # WJ7112 for violations of Wis. Stat. ch. 50 or Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 89, which establish the grounds for this action. SOD # WJ7112 is enclosed.

ORDER TO COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS

1. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 89.56(3)(a), effective immediately, the operator shall comply with the requirements specified by Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 89 that establishes the standards for the operation of the Residential Care Apartment Complex in order to protect and promote the health, safety and welfare of the tenants.

AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AND WITHOUT DELAY, within 45 days of receipt of this notice, the operator shall achieve and maintain substantial compliance with all requirements. All operational and tenant records required as evidence of compliance with applicable rules will be available to department representatives upon request.

*According to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 89.56(2), you are ordered to submit a Plan of Correction via an attestation of compliance. In satisfaction of this requirement: Insert the name of the facility in the space provided on the Attestation of Correction form F-02172. Within **ten (10)** days of receipt of this NOTICE and ORDER, return the completed Attestation of Correction F-02172 to the Bureau of Assisted Living Northeastern Regional Office at 200 North Jefferson Street, Suite 501, Green Bay, WI 54301.*

The Department may, without notice, conduct an inspection to verify the operator's corrective action at any time after the date of compliance. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.034(10), the department may impose a \$200 inspection fee for an on-site inspection to review compliance of violations resulting in enforcement action.

ADDITIONALLY:

WITHIN 10 DAYS of receipt of this notice, the operator may request an extension for the date of compliance. The request for an extension must be submitted to the Assisted Living Regional Director, Northeastern Regional Office, at DHSDQABALNERO@dhs.wisconsin.gov. The Regional Director will communicate to the operator a decision on the date of compliance extension.

ORDER NOT TO ADMIT NEW OR ADDITIONAL TENANTS

Based on the results of the Department's inspection, and monitoring visit, and pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.034(2)(e), and Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 89.56(3)(d), **EFFECTIVE UPON RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE and ORDER**, the Department of Health Services **HEREBY ORDERS** that **Patriot Place RCAC NOT ADMIT ANY NEW OR ADDITIONAL TENANTS** until all violations in SOD #WJ7112 are corrected, compliance is verified by the Department, and this Order is rescinded in writing.

SPECIAL ORDERS

Based on the results of the Department's inspection, and monitoring visit, and pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.034(2)(e), **EFFECTIVE UPON RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE and ORDER**, the Department of Health Services **HEREBY ORDERS** that **Patriot Place RCAC**:

1. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 89.56(3)(c), the operator shall develop and implement corrective measures to ensure all facility staff protect and promote each tenant's right to live in a home that is safe, clean and well-maintained. The operator shall document the corrective actions that will be (or have been) implemented to resolve each deficiency identified in Statement of Deficiency (SOD) WJ7112.

WITHIN 45 days of receipt of this notice, the operator shall:

- Provide all management staff and caregivers with in-service training from a qualified professional on the topics of tenant rights; and recognizing, investigating, documenting, and reporting allegations of abuse, neglect, misappropriation of tenant property, and injuries of unknown origin.**
- Training will be documented in employee files and will include the date/duration of training, the signature/qualifications of the instructor, and an outline of course content.**
- Develop (or review and revise, as necessary) and implement a written policy/procedure to address caregiver misconduct and will ensure the policy incorporates requirements specified by Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 13 and ch. DHS 89. Refer to the following:

2. Pursuant to Wis. Adm. Code §§ DHS 89.56(3)(c) and (3)(e), the RCAC will document a complete investigation report of the alleged incidents of misappropriation of property and abuse described in Statement of Deficiency (SOD) WJ7112. The investigation will conform to requirements and guidelines specified by Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 13 and ch. DHS 89. Within 7 days of receipt of this notice, the facility will submit a copy of the investigation report to the Department's Office of Caregiver Quality.

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE*

According to Wis. Stat. § 50.034(2)(e), and Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 89.56(4), the Department of Health Services may impose a forfeiture for violations of the applicable statutory provisions or administrative rules governing RCACs. If imposed, the forfeiture amount may not be less than \$10 or more than \$1,000 per day for each violation.

The Department has determined there are violations of state statutes or administrative code provisions, or both, as identified in the enclosed SOD #WJ7112.

* According to Art. X, §2 of the Wisconsin Constitution and Wis. Stat. § 50.034(8)(d), all forfeitures collected by the Department are deposited in the State's School Fund.

Therefore, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 50.034(2)(e), and Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 89.56(4), **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that a total **FORFEITURE OF \$4,400.00 IS IMPOSED** for the following violations described in SOD #WJ7112.

You must pay the Total Forfeiture amount within ten (10) days of receipt of this NOTICE and ORDER.

REDUCED FORFEITURE OPTION

If you choose not to appeal the forfeiture, any of the violations in SOD #WJ7112, **AND** any Orders contained in this NOTICE and ORDER, then the Department will reduce the total forfeiture due by 35%.

This 35% reduced forfeiture option also applies to any accruing forfeiture. Final calculation of any accruing forfeiture due will be based on a verified date of compliance.

At this time, the reduced forfeiture amount due to the Department within ten (10) days of receipt of this NOTICE and ORDER is \$2,899.00.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

According to Wis. Stat. § 50.034(8)(c) and Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 89.59, you may request an administrative hearing of the Department’s action. To notify the Department of your request for a hearing, your written request **must be filed with the Division of Hearings and Appeals (DHA) within ten (10) days after receipt of this NOTICE**. Please note, according to Wis. Admin. Code § DHS 89.59(2), an appeal is filed on the date that it is received by the Division of Hearings and Appeals. Send your request for a hearing to:

Include in your written request for a hearing **ALL** of the following:

- ✓ The name and address of the facility;
- ✓ A description of the action being appealed (attach a copy of this NOTICE to your appeal);
- ✓ The effective date of the action;
- ✓ A concise statement of the reasons for objecting to the action;
- ✓ What type of relief you are seeking; and
- ✓ The name, address and telephone number of any person who may be expected to appear on behalf of the facility.

YOUR APPEAL MAY BE DENIED OR DISMISSED IF THE REQUEST IS INCOMPLETE OR NOT FILED WITH DHA WITHIN THE 10-DAY APPEAL TIME.

Please note that according to Wis. Stat. § 50.034(8)(d), if you file an appeal, then payment of any forfeiture is due within ten (10) days after you receive the final decision in the case after exhaustion of administrative review.

NOTICE OF REVISIT FEE

According to Wis. Stat. § 50.034(10), if the Department takes enforcement action against a residential care apartment complex for violation of this subchapter or rules promulgated under it, and the Department subsequently conducts an onsite inspection to review the facility's action to correct the violation(s), the Department may impose a \$200 inspection fee on the residential care apartment complex.

On September 15, 2023, a verification visit was concluded at Patriot Place RCAC by the Division of Quality Assurance, Bureau of Assisted Living, to determine if the violation(s) contained in Statement of Deficiency (SOD) #WJ7111 were corrected. **Therefore, an inspection fee of \$200 is being assessed.**

The revisit fee is due within ten (10) days of receipt of this Notice. Failure to submit this revisit fee will result in additional department action against Patriot Place RCAC. There are no appeal rights for revisit fees.
