The CD-ROM version of the handbook offers full-text search capabilities, links to all sections of the handbook, and up-to-date information.

### All-Provider, other Medicaid handbooks available on CD-ROM

Wisconsin Medicaid recently began sending a CD-ROM version of the All-Provider Handbook to newly certified providers and providers who would like to purchase an additional copy of the handbook. The CD-ROM version of the All-Provider Handbook contains the following:

- A complete, searchable copy of the handbook, which was issued in June 2000.
- A Portable Document Format (PDF) version of the handbook.
- A Handbook User's Guide.
- Instructions for accessing files from the CD-ROM.
- A copy of Adobe Acrobat Reader® that can be downloaded from the CD-ROM.
- A Microsoft® Internet Explorer setup file that can be downloaded from the CD-ROM

Providers who wish to receive a CD-ROM version of the All-Provider Handbook should complete and submit the All-Provider Handbook Order form found in Attachment 1 of this *Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update*. Providers may purchase the CD-ROM version for \$4.00 plus applicable sales tax.

Other Medicaid handbooks that are currently on CD-ROM include the Pharmacy Handbook and the Family Care Guide. Both of these CD-ROMs include a copy of the All-Provider Handbook.

#### Benefits of handbooks on CD-ROM

Handbooks on CD-ROM offer several benefits, both to providers and to Wisconsin Medicaid. Among these benefits are the following:

- Full-text search capabilities. When a
  provider enters any word that relates to the
  topic for which he or she is searching, the
  search function on the CD-ROM will bring
  up all references within the handbook to
  that word or any variation of the word.
- Easy access to all handbook sections.
   The handbook CD-ROM provides links to related information, even when this information is in a different section of the handbook.

- Less storage required. The smaller physical size of the CD-ROM means less space is needed for storage of Wisconsin Medicaid information, especially for providers who use multiple handbooks.
- Current information. Handbooks on CD-ROM will be updated and re-sent each time the handbook is revised.
- Information is easily shared. Handbooks on CD-ROM can be copied to the personal computers of other staff members.

The All-Provider Handbook and other Wisconsin Medicaid handbooks, in addition to *Updates*, may be viewed on the Wisconsin Medicaid Web site at *www.dhfs.state.wi.us/medicaid/*. The online version of the All-Provider Handbook offers the following features:

- Easy access to each chapter and chapter heading via the navigation menu at the top of each page.
- Links at the top and bottom of each page, which include areas within the All-Provider Handbook, as well as links to information and Web sites outside of the handbook.

## New Medicare crossover claim agreements established

Wisconsin Medicaid recently established four new Medicare crossover claim agreements. This *Wisconsin Medicaid* and *BadgerCare Update* includes information about the following:

- Wisconsin Medicaid's current Medicare crossover claim agreements.
- Updating Medicare identification numbers.
- Cross-referencing Medicaid and Medicare identification numbers.

### Wisconsin Medicaid establishes new Medicare crossover claim agreements

Wisconsin Medicaid recently established crossover claim agreements with the following Medicare intermediaries and carriers:

- Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida.
- Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Maryland.
- Riverbend (also known as Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Tennessee).
- Trailblazer Health Enterprises, LLC (also known as Blue Cross and Blue Shield of South Carolina).

Wisconsin Medicaid can now process *automatic* crossover claims from these Medicare intermediaries and carriers. For more Medicare crossover claim information, refer to the Coordination of Benefits section of the All-Provider Handbook.

### Wisconsin Medicaid's current Medicare crossover claim agreements

### **Updating Medicare identification numbers**

Claims will not cross over automatically if
Wisconsin Medicaid does not have the
provider's current Medicare identification
number on file. Wisconsin Medicaid providers
who submit claims to any of the intermediaries
or carriers listed above can contact
Wisconsin Medicaid to update their provider
files with their Medicare identification numbers.
Providers should contact Wisconsin Medicaid
by telephone or in writing when their Medicare
identification numbers change by doing one of
the following:

  - Select the interactive, text-only, or Portable Document Format (PDF) of the All-Provider Handbook.

  - Print and complete the form and mail it to Wisconsin Medicaid Provider Maintenance at the address above.

### **Cross-referencing Wisconsin Medicaid** and Medicare numbers

Providers who have experienced problems with their claims not automatically crossing over to Wisconsin Medicaid should contact Provider Services to verify that their Medicare number is properly cross-referenced with their Medicaid identification number.
