# Wisconsin Medicaid introduces Guide to the **Tuberculosis-Related Services Only Benefit**

Wisconsin Medicaid is introducing the Guide to the Tuberculosis-Related Services Only Benefit. The guide offers provider information on covered services and claims submission information for recipients eligible for tuberculosis-related services only.

## Guide to the Tuberculosis-Related **Services Only Benefit**

The Guide to the Tuberculosis-Related Services Only Benefit for Medicaid-certified providers is now available. The guide incorporates current provider information on covered services and claims submission information for recipients eligible for the special benefit category of tuberculosis-related services only. For all other recipients, providers should refer to their service-specific Medicaid publications. This guide replaces the March 1996 Wisconsin Medicaid Update (96-03), titled "New Tuberculosis (TB) Benefit."

The guide does not replace the All-Provider Handbook, Wisconsin Administrative Code, or Wisconsin Statutes. Subsequent changes to TBrelated policies will be published first in Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Updates and later incorporated into the Guide to the Tuberculosis-Related Services Only Benefit.
