Medicaid basic training and Provider Electronic Solutions software training offered in November

Wisconsin Medicaid is conducting Medicaid basic training and Provider Electronic Solutions (PES) software training in November. Registration is required; however, Wisconsin Medicaid does not charge a fee for attending.

Medicaid basic training

The Medicaid basic training is for **new** providers and **new** billing staff who need to increase their basic knowledge of Wisconsin Medicaid. Attendees will obtain general, all-provider information but will not receive service-specific billing and policy information. More experienced providers and staff should call Provider Services or their Professional Relations Representative with questions regarding Wisconsin Medicaid and with issues regarding specific claims.

Medicaid basic training is intended to supply new providers and new billing staff with general, all-provider information. The agenda, which is the same for all sessions, includes the following topics:

- Eligibility and the Forward card.
- Other insurance codes.
- Medicare disclaimer codes and crossover claims.
- Claims submission and claims adjustments.
- Remittance and Status Reports.
- Review of present and future changes due to the federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) implementation.

It is important that providers bring a paper copy of the All-Provider Handbook to the training. All

Provider Electronic Solutions software training

Wisconsin Medicaid is offering training on the Provider Electronic Solutions (PES) software. The PES software is HIPAA compliant and replaces the Wisconsin Medicaid billing software supported by Proservices. The training will cover how Wisconsin Medicaid and Health Insurance Risk Sharing Plan (HIRSP) providers and electronic billing services will submit HIPAA-compliant electronic claims and adjustments to Wisconsin Medicaid and HIRSP. This includes the 837 Health Care Claim: Dental (commonly referred to as the 837D), the 837 Health Care Claim: Professional (commonly referred to as the 837P), and the 837 Health Care Claim: Institutional (commonly referred to as the 837I).

Refer to the September 2003 *Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update* (2003-145), titled "Free HIPAA-compliant claims submission software is available," for more information.

A copy of the PES software and manual will be given to attendees.

Registration

Wisconsin Medicaid does not charge providers a fee to attend Medicaid Basic or PES software training; however, providers who wish to attend need to register by October 28, 2003. Although the *Update* refers to Medicaid recipients, all information applies to BadgerCare recipients also.
