## SeniorCare chapter of Wisconsin Administrative Code available

The SeniorCare chapter of the Wisconsin Administrative Code (HFS 109) is now available to providers from Wisconsin Medicaid. Regulations associated with the Wisconsin Medicaid SeniorCare program are covered in HFS 109, Wis. Admin. Code.

## **About HFS 109**

The Wisconsin Administrative Code provides the framework and legal regulations providers must adhere to when providing services to SeniorCare participants. Chapter HFS 109, Wis. Admin. Code, contains the following information specific to SeniorCare:

- General provisions.
- Eligibility for SeniorCare benefits and services.
- Drug benefits.
- Program integrity.
- Provider rights and responsibilities.
- Participant rights and responsibilities.
- Program administration.
