The Wisconsin Medicaid companion documents for the federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA)-compliant TA1 Interchange Acknowledgment and 997 Functional Acknowledgment are now available from Wisconsin Medicaid. These companion documents provide information for interpreting the TA1 Interchange Acknowledgment and 997 Functional Acknowledgment transactions received from Wisconsin Medicaid.

A future Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update will notify providers of implementation dates.

The Wisconsin Medicaid companion documents for the federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA)compliant* TA1 Interchange Acknowledgment and 997 Functional Acknowledgment transactions, commonly referred to as the TA1 and 997, are now available from Wisconsin Medicaid. Companion documents provide Wisconsin Medicaid-specific information that should be used with the national HIPAA Implementation Guides. Implementation Guides define the electronic format and values for each data element within an electronic transaction. These companion documents provide

information for interpreting the TA1 and 997 received from Wisconsin Medicaid. The TA1 is the format standard for reporting files rejected for interchange level errors. The 997 is the format standard for reporting transactions accepted and transactions rejected. Companion documents will be effective with the implementation of HIPAA. A future Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update will notify providers of the implementation dates.
