## Changes to Immunization CPT Procedure Codes

This Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update provides information about additions and changes to the Current Procedural Terminology codes for immunizations for HealthCheck providers.

#### Procedure Code Changes for Immunizations

This Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update provides information about additions and changes to Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) procedure codes. Refer to the Attachment of this Update for a complete list of allowable immunization, laboratory test, and other test procedure codes for HealthCheck providers. The Attachment replaces the Attachment in the December 2003 Update (2003-162), titled "Immunization CPT procedure code changes."

### **New Immunization Codes**

Wisconsin Medicaid has adopted two new immunization CPT procedure codes. The following codes are effective for dates of service (DOS) on and after September 1, 2005:

- 90714 (Td, preservative free, for 7 and older).
- 90734 (Meningococcal conjugate vaccine, serogroups A, C, Y and W-135 [tetravalent], for intramuscular use).

The revised description for procedure code 90715 (Tetanus, diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis vaccine [Tdap], for use in individuals 7 years or older, for intramuscular use) will be effective for DOS on and after September 1, 2005. The Tdap vaccine will be covered by the Vaccines for Children Program effective for DOS on and after October 15, 2005.

## **Noncovered Immunization Code**

Effective for DOS on and after September 1, 2005, Wisconsin Medicaid will no longer reimburse procedure code 90701 (Diphtheria, tetanus toxoids, and whole cell pertussis vaccine [DTP], for intramuscular use).

# Information Regarding Medicaid HMOs

This *Update* contains Medicaid fee-for-service policy and applies to providers of services to recipients on fee-for-service Medicaid only. For Medicaid HMO or managed care policy, contact the appropriate managed care organization. Wisconsin Medicaid HMOs are required to provide at least the same benefits as those provided under fee-for-service arrangements. The *Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update* is the first source of program policy and billing information for providers.

Although the *Update* refers to Medicaid recipients, all information applies to BadgerCare recipients also.
