Site of Service Revenue Codes for Rural Health Clinic and Federally Qualified Health Center Cost Reports

New and redefined Medicare site of service revenue codes may be considered an allowable encounter on Rural Health Clinic and Federally Qualified Health Center cost reports for dates of service on and after July 1, 2006.

New Site of Service Revenue Codes

Effective for dates of service on and after July 1, 2006, new and redefined Medicare site of service revenue codes received by Wisconsin Medicaid on Medicare crossover claims may be considered an allowable encounter on Rural Health Clinic (RHC) and Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) cost reports. Refer to the Attachment of this *Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update* for a list of the new and redefined site of service codes.

Note: Site of service revenue code 0527 is not applicable for cost reporting purposes as there are currently no home health shortage areas in Wisconsin.

Information Regarding Medicaid HMOs

This *Update* contains Medicaid fee-for-service policy and applies to providers of services to recipients on fee-for-service Medicaid only. For Medicaid HMO or managed care policy, contact the appropriate managed care organization. Wisconsin Medicaid HMOs are required to provide at least the same benefits as those provided under fee-for-service arrangements.

Although the *Update* refers to Medicaid recipients, all information applies to BadgerCare recipients also.

New and Redefined Site of Service Codes for Rural Health Clinic and Federally Qualified Health Center Cost Reports

Effective for Dates of Service On and After July 1, 2006

Revenue Code	Definition
0521	Clinic visit by member* to RHC/FQHC
0522	Home visit by RHC/FQHC practitioner (for home address visits to the FQHC/RHC member)
0524	Visit by RHC/FQHC practitioner to a member in a covered Part A stay at the SNF
0525	Visit by RHC/FQHC practitioner to a member in an SNF (not in a covered Part A stay) or NF or ICF MR or other residential facility
0528	Visit by RHC/FQHC practitioner to other non-RHC/FQHC site (e.g., scene of accident)

^{*}A "member" is defined as someone who has a history of receiving medical care and whose medical record is located at a specific RHC/FQHC.
