Revenue Codes No Longer Covered

Following the National Uniform Billing Committee's (NUBC) definition of revenue code use, the following revenue codes are re-designated as "Reserved for Future Assignment." Claims submitted to Wisconsin Medicaid with any of the following NUBC revenue codes will be denied, effective for dates of service on and after September 1, 2007:

- 0599.
- 0709.
- 0719.
- 0749.
- 0759.
- 0779.
- 0789.
- 0799.

As a replacement for these revenue codes, providers should bill the general classification revenue code in the same revenue code category ending in "0" on the UB-04 or the UB-92 claim form. For example, revenue code 0710 may be used in place of revenue code 0719.

Information Regarding Medicaid HMOs

This *Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update* contains Medicaid fee-for-service policy and applies to providers of services to recipients on fee-for-service Medicaid only. For Medicaid HMO or managed care policy, contact the appropriate managed care organization. Wisconsin Medicaid HMOs are required to provide at least the same benefits as those provided under fee-for-service arrangements.

The *Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update* is the first source of program policy and billing information for providers.

Although the *Update* refers to Medicaid recipients, all information applies to BadgerCare recipients also.
