## New Place of Service Code

Effective immediately, Wisconsin Medicaid accepts place of service (POS) code 13 (Assisted Living Facility) for services provided by nurse midwives, nurse practitioners, physicians, and physician assistants. Place of service code 13 is an allowable POS code for the previously listed providers for *Current Procedural Terminology* procedure codes 99324-99337 (Domiciliary, rest home [e.g., boarding home], or custodial care services).

## **Information Regarding Medicaid HMOs**

This Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update contains Medicaid fee-for-service policy and applies to providers of services to recipients on fee-for-service Medicaid only. For Medicaid HMO or managed care policy, contact the appropriate managed care organization. Wisconsin Medicaid HMOs are required to provide at least the same benefits as those provided under fee-for-service arrangements.

The *Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Update* is the first source of program policy and billing information for providers.

Although the *Update* refers to Medicaid recipients, all information applies to BadgerCare recipients also.
