National Provider Identifier Requirements with the Implementation of ForwardHealth interChange

With the implementation of ForwardHealth interChange in November 2008, health care providers will be required to use National Provider Identifiers (NPIs) when conducting business with ForwardHealth. National Provider Identifiers will replace the present eight-digit provider numbers currently assigned by ForwardHealth programs. These changes are to ensure compliance with federal NPI regulations that require NPI use effective May 23, 2008.

These requirements apply to health care providers who render services to members enrolled in Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, SeniorCare, Wisconsin Chronic Disease Program, and the Wisconsin Well Woman Program.

The information in this *ForwardHealth Update* introduces NPI requirements that are new to all programs and details requirements that will be applicable to some programs and provider types for the first time with implementation on ForwardHealth interChange.

ForwardHealth and ForwardHealth interChange

In November 2008, the Department of Health Services will implement ForwardHealth interChange, which replaces Wisconsin's existing Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS). ForwardHealth interChange will be supported as part of the State's new fiscal agent contract with EDS. With ForwardHealth interChange, providers and trading partners will have

more ways to verify member enrollment and submit electronic claims, adjustments, and prior authorization (PA) requests through the secure ForwardHealth Portal. Refer to the March 2008 *ForwardHealth Update* (2008-24), titled "Introducing ForwardHealth interChange, a New Web-Based Information System for State Health Care Programs," for an overview of the implementation, business process enhancements, and added benefits the new system will provide.

With the implementation of ForwardHealth interChange, health care providers will be required to use National Provider Identifiers (NPIs) when conducting business with ForwardHealth. This requirement will include using NPI and related data, if applicable, for all provider fields on paper and electronic claims. National Provider Identifiers will replace the present eight-digit provider numbers currently assigned by ForwardHealth programs. These changes are to ensure compliance with federal NPI regulations that require NPI use effective May 23, 2008.

These requirements apply to health care providers who render services to members enrolled in Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, SeniorCare, Wisconsin Chronic Disease Program (WCDDP), and the Wisconsin Well Woman Program (WWWP).

The information in this *Update* introduces NPI requirements that are new to all programs and details requirements that will be applicable to some programs and provider types for the first time with implementation on ForwardHealth interChange.

Provider Exceptions to National Provider Identifier Requirements

Personal care only providers, specialized medical vehicle providers, blood banks, and Community Care Organizations are exempt from the NPI requirement. These are the only providers required to continue to use their current provider number after implementation of ForwardHealth interChange.

Reporting National Provider Identifier to ForwardHealth

Health care providers who have not reported their NPI to ForwardHealth are required to do so before using it to conduct business. Without reporting NPI, ForwardHealth will not be able to identify the provider and access the provider file that stores information used for processing transactions. This may result in claim denials or delays in processing transactions and payments.

Providers may report NPIs or change previously reported NPI information by completing the National Provider Identifier Collection form, F-13505 (10/08), in Attachment 1 of this *Update*. Completed forms may be submitted by fax at (608) 221-2163 or mailed to the address listed on the form. The form may be photocopied.

When reporting NPI, WCDP providers are required to adhere to the following guidelines, as they apply:

- If a provider is certified with WCDP and Medicaid, ForwardHealth will presume the provider's NPI previously reported to Medicaid by the provider also applies to his or her WCDP certification. In this instance, providers are not required to separately report his or her NPI to ForwardHealth.

- If a provider is certified with WCDP and Medicaid and the provider's NPI is not the same for both program certifications, providers are required to separately report his or her WCDP NPI and Medicaid NPI to ForwardHealth.
- If a provider is certified with WCDP only, the provider is required to report his or her NPI to ForwardHealth.

When reporting NPI, WWWP providers are required to adhere to the following guidelines, as they apply:

- If a provider is certified with WWWP and Medicaid, ForwardHealth will presume the provider's NPI previously reported to Medicaid by the provider also applies to their WWWP certification. In this instance, providers are not required to separately report his or her NPI to ForwardHealth.
- If a provider is certified with WWWP and Medicaid and the provider's NPI is not the same for both program certifications, providers are required to separately report his or her WWWP NPI and Medicaid NPI to ForwardHealth.
- If a provider is certified with WWWP only, the provider is required to report his or her NPI to ForwardHealth.

If a provider is certified for Medicaid, WCDP, and WWWP and the provider's NPI is not the same for any of the program certifications, the provider is required to separately report his or her Medicaid, WCDP, and WWWP NPIs to ForwardHealth.

Entity Type 1 and Entity Type 2 National Provider Identifiers

Providers should ensure that they have obtained an appropriate NPI to correspond to their certification. There are two kinds of NPIs — Entity Type 1 NPIs are for *individuals* who provide health care, such as a physician, dentist, and chiropractor. Entity Type 2 NPIs are for *organizations* that provide health care such as a hospital, group practice, pharmacy, and home health agency.

It is possible for a provider to qualify for both Entity Type 1 and Entity Type 2 NPIs. For example, an individual physical therapist may also be the owner of a therapy group that is a corporation and have two Wisconsin Medicaid certifications — one certification as an individual physical therapist and the other certification as the physical therapy group. A Type 1 NPI for the individual certification and a Type 2 NPI for the group certification are required.

NPIs and classifications may be viewed on the National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) Web site <https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov/NPPES/Welcome.do>. Refer to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services Web site at www.cms.hhs.gov/ for more Type 1 and Type 2 NPI information.

National Provider Identifier and Related Data

Some providers hold multiple certifications with ForwardHealth. For example, a health care organization may be certified according to the type of services their organization provides (e.g. physician group, therapy group, home health agency) or the organization may have separate certification for each practice location. ForwardHealth maintains a separate provider file for each certification that stores information used for processing electronic and paper transactions (e.g., provider type and specialty, certification begin and end dates). When a single NPI is reported for multiple certifications, ForwardHealth requires additional data to identify the provider and to determine the correct provider file to use when processing transactions.

Either or both of the following additional data are required on transactions with NPI when a single NPI has been reported for multiple certifications:

- Taxonomy code that is designated by ForwardHealth for the provider's certification.
- ZIP+4 code (complete, nine digits) that corresponds to the practice location address (formerly known as the physical address) on file with ForwardHealth.

Taxonomy Codes

Taxonomy codes are standard code sets used to provide information about provider type and specialty for the provider's certification. The taxonomy code designated by ForwardHealth is required when the NPI reported to ForwardHealth corresponds to multiple certifications and the provider's practice location ZIP+4 code does not uniquely identify the provider.

ForwardHealth designates a taxonomy code as additional data to be used to correctly match NPI to the correct provider file. The ForwardHealth-designated taxonomy code may be different than the taxonomy code providers originally submitted to the NPPES when obtaining their NPI as not all national taxonomy code options are recognized by ForwardHealth. For example, some taxonomy codes may correspond to provider types not certifiable with ForwardHealth, or they may represent services not covered by ForwardHealth.

Omission of a taxonomy code when it is required as additional data to identify the provider or indicating a taxonomy code that is not designated by ForwardHealth will cause claims and other transactions to be denied or delayed in processing.

Note: The ForwardHealth-designated taxonomy code does not change provider certification or affect reimbursement terms.

Providers should refer to Attachment 2 for their appropriate ForwardHealth-designated taxonomy codes and retain this attachment for future reference.

Additionally, all providers are cautioned that any changes to their provider type and/or specialty information on file with ForwardHealth may alter the applicable taxonomy code required when conducting business with ForwardHealth. Providers may refer to Attachment 2 for their appropriate taxonomy code for any changes made after implementation of ForwardHealth.

ZIP+4 Code

The ZIP+4 code is the ZIP code of a provider's practice location address (formerly known as the physical address) on file with ForwardHealth. Providers are required to keep their information on file with ForwardHealth current, including address information. Providers are cautioned that changes to their practice location address on file with ForwardHealth may alter their ZIP+4 code information that is required on transactions. Providers may verify the ZIP+4 code for their address on the U.S. Postal Service Web site at www.usps.com/.

Claims

ForwardHealth will require health care providers to use NPIs and related data, if applicable, for billing, rendering, referring, attending, and prescribing health care providers on all paper and electronic claims for all programs under ForwardHealth.

Paper Claim Forms

After implementation of ForwardHealth interChange, paper claim forms submitted by health care providers without NPI and related data, if applicable, will result in claims being denied.

Note: National Provider Identifiers and related data will only be accepted on paper claims after implementation of ForwardHealth interChange. Indicating NPI on paper claims prior to implementation will result in claims being denied.

Service-specific *Updates* for BadgerCare Plus, Medicaid, SeniorCare, and WCDP providers and program-specific *Updates* for WWWP providers detail changes to paper claim forms with completion instructions and sample claim forms. These *Updates* are available on the ForwardHealth Web site at dhs.wisconsin.gov/forwardhealth/.

Electronic Claims Transactions

National Provider Identifier and related data (taxonomy code and ZIP+4), if applicable, will be required on 837 Health Care Claim standard electronic transactions and National Council for Prescription Drug Programs Telecommunications Standard Format Version 5.1 (NCPDP 5.1).

Companion documents incorporating NPI and related data for electronic transactions are available on the ForwardHealth Portal at www.forwardhealth.wi.gov/. Providers should work with their trading partners, clearinghouses, billing services, and other vendors that may be affected by companion document changes to ensure they are prepared for NPI modifications to standard electronic transactions.

National Council for Prescription Drug Programs 5.1 Telecommunications Standard

National Provider Identifier will be required on NCPDP 5.1 transactions. There are no data elements for the taxonomy code or ZIP+4 code on the NCPDP 5.1 transaction and the drug paper claim format will not allow for the inclusion of a taxonomy code, therefore, it is imperative that providers obtain and use a unique NPI for each certification for successful billing after ForwardHealth implementation.

Providers who do not obtain a unique NPI for each certification will be asked to select one certification as the "default" certification. Claims will be processed using the provider file information from the default certification.

Refer to the NCPDP 5.1 companion documents on the Portal at www.forwardhealth.wi.gov/.

Prescriber ID Modification for National Council for Prescription Drug Programs 5.1 Telecommunications Standard

Per 2003 Wisconsin Act 272, providers may not disclose a practitioner's federal registration number without

consent. With implementation of ForwardHealth interChange, NPI only will be accepted in the Prescriber ID field of NCPDP 5.1 transactions. Drug Enforcement Agency numbers will no longer be accepted for the Prescriber ID. Billing providers may use the prescriber's NPI or the pharmacy's NPI if the prescriber's NPI is not available for real-time pharmacy claims.

Crossover Claims

National Provider Identifier and related data, as detailed in this *Update*, will be required on crossover claims, in most instances. However, in some cases the taxonomy code designated by ForwardHealth may not be indicated on automatic crossover claims received from Medicare.

837 Health Care Claims: Professional Crossover Claims

Professional crossover claims received by ForwardHealth from Medicare may not have the taxonomy code of the billing provider indicated on the transaction. Medicare will not accept the 837 Health Care Claim: Professional (837P) transaction when a taxonomy code is reported in both the Billing/Pay-to Provider Loop (2000A) and in the Rendering Provider Loop (2310B) if the billing and rendering providers are different. For example, a transaction with a physician group indicated as the billing provider and the individual physician indicated as the rendering provider.

Providers should resubmit professional crossover claims to ForwardHealth when the taxonomy code is required to identify the billing provider and it is not indicated on the crossover claim received from Medicare. Taxonomy codes for billing and rendering providers may be required if the provider has a single NPI for multiple ForwardHealth provider certifications. Providers should refer to the 837 companion documents for information on using taxonomy codes on standard claims transactions. ForwardHealth will accept the 837P transaction when a taxonomy code is reported in both the Billing/Pay-to Provider Loop (2000A) and in the

Rendering Provider Loop (2310B) and the billing and rendering providers are different.

This ForwardHealth requirement is inconsistent with the instructions in the 837P Implementation Guide; however, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has acknowledged that health plans may need the billing provider taxonomy in order to accurately process claims. Refer to the CMS Web site for Frequently Asked Question (#8585) at <https://questions.cms.hhs.gov/> for further information.

Taxonomy Code Designated by ForwardHealth

The taxonomy code indicated on automatic crossover claims received from Medicare may be different than the taxonomy code designated by ForwardHealth. Providers should resubmit the claim to ForwardHealth when the taxonomy code designated by ForwardHealth is required to identify the provider and is not indicated on the crossover claim received from Medicare.

Refer to the August 2008 *Update* (2008-153), titled, "Medicare Crossover Claims for ForwardHealth Providers," for more information on NPI and crossover claims. This *Update* also introduces crossover claims information to WCDP providers.

Prior Authorization

Paper Prior Authorization Request Forms

ForwardHealth will require health care providers to use NPI and related data on paper PA requests. National Provider Identifiers and related data will only be accepted on paper PAs after implementation of ForwardHealth interChange. After implementation of ForwardHealth interChange, paper PAs submitted by health care providers without NPI and related data will result in the PA being returned to the provider unprocessed.

Note: National Provider Identifiers and related data will only be accepted on paper PAs after implementation of ForwardHealth interChange.

Service-specific *Updates* for BadgerCare Plus, Medicaid, and WCDP providers detail changes to paper PA forms with completion instructions and sample PA forms. These *Updates* are available on the ForwardHealth Web site at dhs.wisconsin.gov/forwardhealth/.

Electronic Prior Authorizations

Specialized Transmission Approval Technology-Prior Authorization

National Provider Identifier and related data will be required when using the Specialized Transmission Approval Technology-Prior Authorization (STAT-PA) system. Modifications and revisions to the STAT-PA system are detailed in the following *Updates*:

- June 2008 *Update* (2008-42), titled “Changes to STAT-PA for Retail Pharmacy Drugs.”
- June 2008 *Update* (2008-49), titled “Changes to Prior Authorization for HealthCheck Services,” detailing STAT-PA for environmental lead inspection services.
- June 2008 *Update* (2008-70), titled “Changes to Prior Authorization for Durable Medical Equipment,” detailing STAT-PA for orthopedic shoes.

Portal Prior Authorization

Providers will be able to submit PA requests using the secure Portal. Providers are encouraged to submit PA requests electronically, because it reduces clerical errors that may cause PAs to be returned to the provider unprocessed. Prior authorizations submitted via the Portal will require NPI and related data in order to be entered into the Portal.

Paper Remittance Advice

The new paper Remittance Advice (RA) will replace the current Remittance and Status Report and will be implemented with ForwardHealth interChange. One

RA will be generated per provider certification and will reflect NPI only for health care providers. Providers who have a single NPI that is used for multiple certifications will receive an RA for each certification with the same NPI reported on each of the RAs. For instance, if a hospital has obtained a single NPI and the hospital has a clinic, a lab, and a pharmacy that are all certified with ForwardHealth, the clinic, the lab, and the pharmacy will submit separate claims that indicate the same NPI as the hospital. Separate RAs will be generated for the hospital, the clinic, the lab, and the pharmacy.

Providers that are exempt from NPI requirements will continue to see their provider number, which will be listed as the “Payee ID” reflected on their RA.

Refer to the August 2008 *Update* (2008-135), titled “ForwardHealth Announces the New Remittance Advice,” for more information.

Claims Missing from Remittance Advice

ForwardHealth must be able to identify the billing provider in order to report claim information on the RA. Claims submitted with NPI that fail to appear on the RA are an indication that there is a problem with the matching and identification of the billing provider’s NPI. If claims do not appear on the RA after 30 days of submission, providers should verify that the billing provider’s NPI and the information on file with ForwardHealth matches the data submitted on the original claim. Claims, in these circumstances, should be corrected and resubmitted with the appropriate NPI, designated taxonomy code, and ZIP +4 code.

Other Business

National Provider Identifiers and related data will be required for other business functions with ForwardHealth.

Automated Voice Response System

WiCall, ForwardHealth’s new Automated Voice Response system, will gather inquiry information from

callers through voice prompts and will directly access ForwardHealth interChange. Health care providers will be prompted to enter their NPI, and in some cases related data, in order to retrieve query information through WiCall.

270/271 Health Care Eligibility/Benefit Inquiry

270/271 Health Care Eligibility/Benefit Inquiry (270/271) will accept NPI only. The NPI indicated on the 270 will be verified to ensure that it is associated with a valid certification on file and the 271 response will report the NPI that was indicated on the incoming 270.

Provider Certification and Maintenance

ForwardHealth will require health care providers to report their NPI on the certification application. Additionally, NPI will be required on all documents to update certification information.

Obtaining an NPI does not replace the ForwardHealth certification process. Providers are responsible for obtaining the appropriate ForwardHealth program certifications for each NPI used to conduct business with ForwardHealth.

Provider Services Inquiries

The ForwardHealth Provider Services Call Center will be available to assist providers in all programs. Health care providers contacting Provider Services will be asked for their NPI and related data. This information will be required to ensure accurate provider identification for call center correspondents to access electronic information relevant to the inquiry.

Information for Medicaid-Certified Health Care Providers

Elimination of Contract Information Segment (CN1) Value Codes

Contract Information Segment (CN1) value codes will no longer be required on claims transactions after implementation of ForwardHealth interChange.

Elimination of Hospital Suffix Codes

Hospital providers will no longer be required to indicate a unique provider number ending with a two-digit suffix code on claims and PAs for the following services:

- Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome care.
- Brain injury cases.
- Services provided at critical access hospitals.
- Ventilator-dependent care.

Taxonomy Code Requirements for Federally Qualified Health Centers

With the implementation of ForwardHealth interChange, federally qualified health centers (FQHC) will be required to indicate the specific taxonomy code

that is related to the appropriate certification for the service provided. The taxonomy code allows ForwardHealth to determine the correct provider file and information to use when processing the claim. For example, if an FQHC, certified both as an FQHC clinic provider and an ambulance provider, uses the same NPI for both FQHC and ambulance services and submits a claim for an ambulance service, the taxonomy code for the ambulance certification should be indicated on the claim.

Attachment 3 lists FQHC certifications, the required taxonomy code to be indicated for each certification, and the taxonomy code description after ForwardHealth implementation. These taxonomy codes will be required on electronic transactions, paper forms, inquiries, and cost reports for the consideration of services for cost-based reimbursement when billing.

Note: As with other provider types, the taxonomy code will only be used to correctly identify providers and will not change provider certification or reimbursement terms.

Commercial Health Insurance

Providers are required to submit claims to commercial health insurance when applicable. Claim denials from other payers relating to NPI and related data should be resolved with that payer and not submitted to ForwardHealth. Payments made by ForwardHealth in these situations may be recouped.

The *ForwardHealth Update* is the first source of program policy and billing information for providers.

Wisconsin Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, SeniorCare, and Wisconsin Chronic Disease Program are administered by the Division of Health Care Access and Accountability, Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS). The Wisconsin Well Woman Program is administered by the Division of Public Health, Wisconsin DHS.

FORWARDHEALTH NATIONAL PROVIDER IDENTIFIER COLLECTION

ForwardHealth requires certain information to certify providers and to authorize and pay for medical services provided to eligible members. Personally identifiable information about providers is used for purposes directly related to program administration, such as determining the certification of providers or processing provider claims for reimbursement. Failure to supply the information requested by the form may result in denial of payment for the services.
