Reimbursement Reduction for Most Paper Claims Submitted to ForwardHealth

Effective for claims received after December 10, 2010, most claims submitted to ForwardHealth on paper will be subject to a reimbursement reduction.

Reimbursement Reduction for Most Paper Claims

As a result of the Medicaid Rate Reform project, ForwardHealth will reduce reimbursement on most claims submitted to ForwardHealth on paper. Effective for claims received after December 10, 2010, most paper claims will be subject up to a \$1.10 reimbursement reduction per claim.

Providers are encouraged to submit claims electronically to avoid this reimbursement reduction. Electronic claims submission:

- Adapts to existing system.
- Allows flexible submission methods.

- Improves cash flow.
- Offers efficient and timely payments.
- Reduces billing and processing errors.
- Reduces clerical effort.

For each claim to which a reimbursement reduction was applied, providers will receive an Explanation of Benefits (EOB) message to notify them of the payment reduction. For claims with reimbursement reductions, the EOB will state the following, "This claim is eligible for electronic submission. Up to a \$1.10 reduction has been applied to this claim payment."

If a paid claim's total reimbursement amount is less than \$1.10, ForwardHealth will reduce the payment up to a \$1.10. The claim will show on the Remittance Advice as paid but with a \$0 paid amount.

The reimbursement reduction applies to the following paper claims:

- 1500 Health Insurance Claim Form.
- UB-04 (CMS 1450) Claim Form.
- Compound Drug Claim form, F-13073 (10/08).
- Noncompound Drug Claim form, F-13072 (10/08).

Programs Affected

The reimbursement reduction applies to paper claims submitted to the following programs:

- Wisconsin Medicaid.
- BadgerCare Plus.
- SeniorCare.
- Family Planning Waiver.

The reimbursement reduction does not apply to the following programs:

- Wisconsin Chronic Disease Program.
- Wisconsin Well Woman Program.

Exceptions to Paper Claim Reimbursement Reduction

The reimbursement reduction will not affect the following providers or claims:

- In-state emergency providers.
- Out-of-state providers.
- Medicare crossover claims.
- Any claims that ForwardHealth requires additional supporting information to be submitted on paper.
 For example:
 - ✓ Hysterectomy claims must be submitted along with a paper Acknowledgement of Receipt of Hysterectomy Information form, F-1160 (10/08).
 - ✓ Sterilization claims must be submitted along with a paper Consent for Sterilization form, F-1164 (10/08).
 - ✓ Claims submitted to Timely Filing appeals must be submitted on paper with a Timely Filing Appeals Request form, F-13047 (10/08).

✓ In certain circumstances, drug claims must be submitted on paper with a Pharmacy Special Handling Request, F-13074 (10/08).

Note: Enhancements for submitting claims electronically through the ForwardHealth Portal will be implemented in the near future. Providers should watch for upcoming publications on these enhancements.

Transitioning from Paper to Electronic Claims Submission

Providers are encouraged to submit claims using the following electronic submission options:

- ForwardHealth Portal.
- Provider Electronic Solutions (PES) software.
- 837 Health Care Claims for Electronic Data Interchange (EDI).
- National Council for Prescription Drug Programs.

Paper Attachments for Claims Submitted Electronically

Providers who submit claims electronically may send the attachments to ForwardHealth by mail. The Portal has a Hard-Copy Attachments panel that allows providers to enter the Attachment Control Number, the transmission type, the report type, and a description of the attachment(s) being submitted. Providers can also indicate that a paper attachment will accompany electronic claims when using EDI transactions and PES.

The form that must accompany all attachments is the Claim Form Attachment Cover Page, F-13470 (10/08). Refer to the Claims section of the Online Handbook for more information on mailing paper attachments to ForwardHealth.

The ForwardHealth Update is the first source of program policy and billing information for providers.

Wisconsin Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, SeniorCare, and Wisconsin Chronic Disease Program are administered by the Division of Health Care Access and Accountability, Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS).
