Reminder: Reimbursement for Certain Over-the-Counter Drugs and All Diabetic Supplies Are Included in the Nursing Home Daily Rate

Providers are reminded that reimbursement for certain over-the-counter drugs and all diabetic supplies are included in the nursing home daily rate and are not separately reimbursable when provided to nursing home members.

Reimbursement for Certain Over-the-Counter Drugs and All Diabetic Supplies Are Included in the Nursing Home Daily Rate

Nursing home providers are reminded that reimbursement for certain over-the-counter (OTC) drugs and all diabetic supplies are included in the nursing home daily rate and are not separately reimbursable when provided to nursing home members. ForwardHealth will not reimburse nursing home providers for certain OTC drugs and diabetic supplies on any type of claim (professional, institutional, or noncompound claims).

The following covered OTC drugs are not included in the nursing home daily rate and providers may request separate reimbursement for these OTCs:

- Acne agents.
- Iron supplements for pregnant women.
- Insulin.
- Tobacco cessation.

The OTC list now indicates which OTC drugs are separately reimbursable for members residing in a nursing home.

Reminder to Enddate a Nursing Home Authorization Segment with a Discharge Date

Nursing home providers are reminded to enddate a member's nursing home authorization segment when the member is officially discharged from the nursing home. Providers can do this by submitting an updated Request for Nursing Home Care Determination form, F-01020 (06/12), to ForwardHealth with a nursing home discharge date.

The enddating of a nursing home authorization segment on a member's enrollment file allows the member to access services, such as transportation services by the transportation manager, after the member has been discharged to a community setting and allows other providers, such as

pharmacies, to be reimbursed for services provided to the member. Claims submitted by pharmacies will be denied if the member's nursing home authorization segment is still "active" for the date of service billed.

Information Regarding Managed Care Organizations

This *Update* contains fee-for-service policy and applies to services members receive on a fee-for-service basis only. For managed care policy, contact the appropriate managed care organization. Managed care organizations are required to provide at least the same benefits as those provided under fee-for-service arrangements.

The ForwardHealth Update is the first source of program policy and billing information for providers.
