Revisions to Payer Sheet for All ForwardHealth Programs as a Result of Changes to Claims Submission Requirements for Wisconsin AIDS Drug Assistance Program

This *ForwardHealth Update* announces revisions to the ForwardHealth Payer Sheet: National Council for Prescription Drug Programs version D.0 for all ForwardHealth programs as a result of changes to claims submission requirements for the Wisconsin AIDS Drug Assistance Program, effective November 9, 2013.

The Wisconsin AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) is making changes to its claims submission requirements, which necessitates revision to the ForwardHealth Payer Sheet: National Council for Prescription Drug Programs (NCPDP) version D.0, P-00272 (11/13), for all ForwardHealth programs, effective for claims received on and after November 9, 2013.

New Bank Identification Number Specifically for AIDS Drug Assistance Program

All claims submitted to the ADAP on and after November 9, 2013, must be submitted using a new ADAP-specific bank identification number (BIN), regardless of the date of service on the claim. The new ADAP BIN is **016929**. Claims submitted to the ADAP without the new ADAP BIN will be denied.

Note: As reminder, the ADAP has a closed drug formulary; the ADAP covers antiretroviral drugs, prophylactic drugs,

medications to treat the side effects of antiretroviral therapy, and certain hepatitis C treatments. Drugs not listed on the ADAP drug formulary are considered noncovered services. Coordination of Benefits for AIDS Drug Assistance Program Members Also Enrolled in Medicare Part D

AIDS Drug Assistance Program Is Payer of Last Resort

Providers are required to submit claims for ADAP members who are enrolled in a Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plan (PDP) to the member's PDP and all other health insurance sources before claims are submitted to the ADAP. The ADAP is the payer of last resort after other commercial health insurance sources, Medicare, Health Insurance Risk Sharing Program, Wisconsin Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, and SeniorCare.

To determine the specific PDP in which a member is enrolled, providers should first check with the member. If the member does not know the PDP in which he or she is

enrolled, providers may send an online eligibility transaction through Medicare's E1 query. If the E1 transaction does not return Medicare Part D plan information, providers may call Medicare. Providers may also call Provider Services at (800) 947-9627 to determine the PDP in which a member is enrolled.

Medicare Part D Processor Control Number Required

If an ADAP member is enrolled in a Medicare Part D PDP, then the claim submitted to the ADAP must also include the processor control number (PCN) WIPARTD in NCPDP field 104-A4 (Processor Control Number). Claims received without WIPARTD indicated will be denied.

Note: The PCN WIPARTD should *not* be indicated on claims for ADAP members who are not enrolled in a Medicare Part D PDP or the claims will be denied.

Monthly Medicare Part D Payment Recoupment

ForwardHealth initiates a monthly process of recouping payment for claims for members enrolled in Medicare Part D. Providers will receive adjustments for previously paid claims. Providers may not bill members for services that are adjusted and should seek reimbursement from the member's Medicare Part D PDP. A PDP includes not only the stand-alone Medicare Part D PDPs, but also Medicare Advantage PDPs. Under certain circumstances, claims may have been reimbursed by ForwardHealth without reimbursement having been obtained from a Medicare Part D PDP.

NCPDP Version D.0 Payer Sheet Revised

ForwardHealth has revised the ForwardHealth Payer Sheet: NCPDP Version D.0 to add a second line, where applicable, for the new ADAP BIN. The revised payer sheet is available for download on the HIPAA Version 5010 Companion Guides and NCPDP Version D.0 Payer Sheet page of the Trading Partner area of the Portal at www.forwardhealth.wi.gov/WIPortal/Default.aspx?srcUrl=CompanionDocuments.htm&tabid=41.
