ICD-10 Diagnosis Codes for Targeted Case Management Services

Effective for dates of service on and after October 1, 2015, case management providers will be required to indicate *International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision* diagnosis codes, as applicable, on all claims submitted to ForwardHealth.

ICD-10 Diagnosis Codes to Indicate Target Groups

Effective for dates of service on and after October 1, 2015, case management providers will be required to indicate *International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision* (ICD-10) diagnosis codes, as applicable, on all claims submitted to ForwardHealth.

To identify the specific target group on the claim, providers should refer to the Attachment of this *ForwardHealth Update* and use the appropriate allowable diagnosis code, which corresponds to the specific target group listed, as the primary diagnosis. Any additional diagnoses that are specific to the member should be provided as secondary diagnoses on the claim.

The allowable ICD-10 target group diagnosis codes for case management providers will also be published to the Case Management Providers resources page on the Portal at https://www.forwardhealth.wi.gov/WIPortal/content/Provider/medicaid/CaseManagement/resources_21.htm.spage. After October 1, 2015, the codes will also be published in the ForwardHealth Online Handbook.

Information Regarding Managed Care Organizations

This *Update* contains fee-for-service policy and applies to services members receive on a fee-for-service basis only. For managed care policy, contact the appropriate managed care organization. Managed care organizations are required to provide at least the same benefits as those provided under fee-for-service arrangements.

The *ForwardHealth Update* is the first source of program policy and billing information for providers.

Diagnosis Codes Indicating Target Groups for Case Management Services

The table below includes the allowable primary diagnosis codes for indicating a target group on claims submitted to ForwardHealth for case management services. For claims with dates of services (DOS) on and after October 1, 2015, providers should use *International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision* (ICD-10) diagnosis codes. For claims with DOS before October, 1 2015, providers should continue to use *International Classification of Diseases, Ninth Revision* (ICD-9) diagnosis codes.
