Revised DMS Index

The following changes are effective for dates of service on and after December 1, 1996. The changes are reflected in the attached DMS Index:

●A4927, gloves.

The maximum allowable fees for latex and vinyl gloves are now the same. Therefore, you no longer need documentation of allergy to latex to dispense vinyl gloves.

●B4035-10 and 30, for enteral feeding sets.

The description is expanded to indicate that these procedure codes include the bag and tubing. If you are dispensing only a feeding bag, use the new modifier 40 with B4035. If you are dispensing only the tubing, use the new modifier 50 with B4035.

●B4084-10, extension set for skin level gastrostomy set (pump) and B4084-20, bolus extension set for skin level gastrostomy set (gravity).

These codes are added to use with a skin level gastrostomy tube.

●K0175, corrugated tubing, disposable, used with large volume nebulizer, 100 feet.

This code has a new maximum allowable fee.

●K0192-10, tubing used with suction pump, bulk, 100 feet.

This code is added.

●W6401, skin level gastrostomy feeding tube kit, includes tube, two feeding sets, syringe, and gauze (e.g., Mic-Key).

This code is added. This item will continue to require prior authorization.

●XX007, adhesive remover wipes.

"Ostomy use only" is added to the description for clarification.

●91000-0003-00, IV connector female/female.

This code is added.

●91000-0003-02, 9600-9503-04 and 9600-9503-03, needles.

These three codes are not in the nursing home rate if they are used to prepare IV/IM drugs at a pharmacy.
